

What is Form 1095-C?

Form 1095-C is a tax form that employers send to employees. It provides details about the health insurance coverage that was offered to you by your employer. This form is required by the Affordable Care Act (ACA) and helps the IRS determine whether you and your employer met the requirements of the health care law.

Do You Need Form 1095-C for Your Taxes?

While Form 1095-C is not required to file your federal tax return, it is important to keep it for your records. The information on this form may be relevant for state tax filings in states that enforce individual mandates. It is always a good idea to keep this form with your other tax documents in case you need to refer to it later.

How can I access my 1095-C?

Form 1095-C will be available via PlanSource Ben Admin site, this is the same benefits site you access during Open Enrollment as well as throughout the year for your benefits review.

Quick Tips

- **Log into PlanSource**
 - Username = First initial of your first name and up to six letters of your last name and last four digits of your SSN
 - (Ex. Taylor Williams, last four SSN I234 - username: twilliaI234)
 - Password = Your created password after initial login. If you are having trouble remembering your password, click the Forgot Your Password link or Help, just below the login form.
