ORDER FOR CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE

The Court finds it is in the best interests of the parties to provide for the prompt and efficient administration of Justice. Upon the Court's own motion, It is, therefore

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE REQUIRED. Counsel of record and pro se parties are hereby ordered to attend a Case Management Conference on _____ at the Robert M. Foster Justice Center, 76347 Veterans Way, 3rd Floor, Yulee, Florida 32097, in Chambers, before Steven M. Fahlgren, Circuit Judge. _____
are reserved.

**IT IS MANDATORY THAT THE ATTORNEYS OF RECORD
AND UNREPRESENTED PARTIES ATTEND THE CASE
MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE, UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE COURT.**

2. MATTERS TO BE DISCUSSED. Pursuant to Fla. Fam. L.R.P. 12.200, the Court may (a) schedule or reschedule the service of motions, pleadings, and other documents; (b) set or reset the time of trials, subject to rule 12.440; (c) coordinate the progress of the action if complex litigation factors are present; (d) limit, schedule, order, or expedite discovery; (e) schedule disclosure of expert witnesses and the discovery of facts known and opinions held by such experts; (f) schedule or hear motions related to admission or exclusion of evidence; (g) pursue the possibilities of settlement; (h) require filing of preliminary stipulations if issues can be narrowed; (i) refer issues to a magistrate for findings of fact, if consent is obtained as provided in rules 12.490 and 12.492 and if no significant history of domestic, repeat, dating, or sexual

violence, or stalking that would compromise the process is involved in the case; (j) refer the parties to mediation if no significant history of domestic, repeat, dating, or sexual violence, or stalking that would compromise the mediation process is involved in the case and consider allocation of expenses related to the referral; or refer the parties to counseling if no significant history of domestic, repeat, dating, or sexual violence, or stalking that would compromise the process is involved in the case and consider allocation of expenses related to the referral; (k) coordinate voluntary binding arbitration consistent with Florida law if no significant history of domestic, repeat, dating, or sexual violence, or stalking that would compromise the process is involved in the case; (l) appoint court experts and allocate the expenses for the appointments; (m) refer the cause for a parenting plan recommendation, social investigation and study, home study, or psychological evaluation and allocate the initial expense for that study; (n) appoint an attorney or guardian ad litem for a minor child or children if required and allocate the expense of the appointment; and (o) schedule other conferences or determine other matters that may aid in the disposition of the action.

3. RESCHEDULING OF CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE. A scheduled Case Management Conference will only be rescheduled upon providing a Request to Continue Case Management Conference upon special circumstances. The Request must specify (a) the reason for rescheduling; (b) a certification from the attorneys stating they have discussed the pending issues in the case and have been unable to resolve them; and (c) possible dates and times for rescheduling; (d) with that rescheduled date occurring within thirty (30) days of the original conference date. This Request must be filed seventy two (72) hours prior to the scheduled Case Management Conference.

4. CANCELLATION OF CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE. This Case Management Conference can only be canceled upon the filing with the Court at least twenty four (24) hours prior to the date of the Case Management Conference (a) a signed agreement which resolves all issues. If the case is settled and testimony is needed to support entry of an

Order/Final Judgment, the testimony may be presented at the Case Management Conference.
