ORDER REGARDING FORECLOSURE MATTERS

As the moratoriums of foreclosure matters put in place by the Governor and the local Chief and Administrative Judges have changed, Plaintiff shall serve a copy of the Fourth Judicial Circuit Administrative Order No. 2020-29 regarding Circuit and County Court Foreclosure Sales and Execution of Possessory Writs for Non-Payment, the Coronavirus Relief Funds Notice, and the Court's Foreclosure Court Coronavirus Hearing Addendum, all of which are attached hereto, by US Mail or by service of process, whichever is appropriate pursuant to the applicable rules of procedure, to the parties not enrolled in the Court's e-portal and shall file a certificate of service with the Clerk within the next three (3) business days.

The plaintiff or moving party may submit a proposed order rescheduling previously cancelled case management conferences or non-jury trials to the Court for entry by US Mail with appropriate copies and envelopes for any pro se parties, or request a new hearing date in accordance with the Court's division procedures on any pending matters. The Court's division procedures, hearing request form, and other published forms can be located at <https://www.nassauclerk.com/judge-steven-m-fahlgren/> All notices of hearings and case management orders shall indicate that the parties shall appear via Zoom and reference and attach the Court's above-referenced addendum.
