

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ADDENDUM FOR DIVISION A

Pursuant to the local administrative order entered on June 15, 2021, effective June 21, 2021, the Nassau County Phase 2 Operational Plan has been rescinded and **all parties are required to appear in person for domestic violence hearings. Facemasks are required.**

If any party would like **to appear remotely via Zoom** rather than appearing in person, they shall **file a motion** with the clerk of court at least three (3) business days in advance of the hearing with a copy of their driver's license or photo identification. **If the Court grants a motion to appear via Zoom**, the parties shall appear using the invitation copied below.

The Zoom application can be downloaded to your smart phone, tablet or computer for video appearance. Zoom hearings can be attended by phone even if you do not have a smart phone, tablet or computer with an internet connection.

Parties appearing via Zoom by video shall be prepared to present their driver's license or photo identification for the purposes of being sworn in. Parties appearing via Zoom with audio only shall be in the presence of a notary for the purposes of being sworn in.

When appearing via Zoom, any exhibits the parties intend to introduce into evidence must be submitted to the Clerk of Court at least three (3) business days in advance of the hearing with copies to all parties via email, and to the Court's judicial assistant by email to astrickland@nassauclerk.com.¹ The subject of the email should include the case number and should say, "Copies of Exhibits for Upcoming Hearing" and should not contain any other communications. If proposed exhibits include videos or audio recordings, a flash drive or CD/DVD must be provided to the Clerk of Court at least three (3) business days in advance of hearing. All submissions shall be marked with the relevant case number and date of the hearing.
